RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entrants (between and including ages 17-64 years) must be a member of the Vilna & District Agricultural Society. Membership is \$5.00/year and are available at the time of BENCH SHOW entry. Seniors and under 17 entrants are exempt from entry membership fee.
2. All entry exhibits must be the work or product of the entrant. Any item previously entered in the Vilna Boomtown Days Bench Show will be disqualified from judging.
3. Only one entry per class per entrant will be accepted.
4. Good quality is expected, poor quality items may be disqualified from judging.
5. Those entering the JUNIOR class must state age of entrant on the top of the tag. Those entering the SENIOR class must indicate that on the top of the tag.
6. The Vilna & District Agricultural Society makes every effort to ensure the safety and security of all the exhibits but WILL NOT BE responsible of any damage or loss that occurs.
7. The Judging Standards and Guidelines used are available from Alberta Agriculture, Food, and Rural Development.
8. The modified system of judging will be used. Judging is a subjective process and interpretations many vary. ALL JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
9. All canned DOMESTIC PRODUCTS must be in sealed jars, complete with label of contents (eg. Blueberry Jam) and date produced.
10. All other FOOD and BAKED PRODUCTS to be displayed in a clear Ziploc type bag or appropriate sealed container.
11. Entrant is responsible for the supply of their own display bags or containers as required.
12. All ART WORK and PHOTOGRAPHY to be mounted or framed appropriately and titled.

PRIZES & POINT CALCULATION

- Entrants will receive 50 cents per point awarded.

1st Place - 4 POINTS

2nd Place - 3 POINTS

3rd Place - 2 POINTS

4th Place - 1 POINT

- Overall HIGH POINT winners (min. 16 points required) for ADULT, SENIOR, & JUNIOR categories will receive:
- 1st= \$50, 2nd= \$25, 3rd= \$10
