- All entry exhibits must be the work or product of the entrant. Any item previously entered in the Vilna Boomtown Days bench Show will be disqualified from the judging.
- Only one entry per class per entrant will be accepted.
- Good quality is expected, poor quality items may be disqualified from judging.
- Those entering the Junior class must state the age of the entrant on the top of the tag. Those entering the Senior class must indicate that on the top of the tag.
- The Vilna & District Agricultural Society makes every effort to ensure the safety and security of all the exhibits but IS NOT responsible for any damage or loss that may occur.
- The Judging Standards and Guidelines used are available from Alberta Agriculture, Food and Rural Development.
- The modified system of judging will be used. Judging is a subjective process and interpretations may vary. **THE JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**
- All canned DOMESTIC PRODUCTS must be in sealed jars, complete with a label of contents (e.g. Blueberry Jam) and the date produced.
- All other FOOD and BAKED PRODUCTS are to be displayed in a clear Ziploc type bag or appropriate sealed container.
- Entrants are responsible to supply their own display bags or containers as required.
- All ARTWORK and PHOTOAGRAPHY is to be mounted or framed appropriately and titled.
